Students in Year 1 are encouraged to wear an Easter mask and Year 2 students are invited to carry an Easter basket.

This will give the students a chance to collaborate with their peers and buddies in Year 5/6 in the design and creation process of their item for the parade. The Easter Hat parade supports the students in their experience of creative arts, meeting drama outcomes to represent familiar events and characters.

Students are encouraged to bring in a named bag of materials prior to Friday 22 March to help them make their Easter hat, mask or basket.

To enable parents/carers to attend this event, the parade will be held in stage levels. Parents/carers are required to sign in via the David Street entrance.

   Year 1 will make and wear an Easter mask (cardboard mask with string, stickers, feathers, egg shapes etc.)
   Year 2 will make and carry an Easter basket (plastic/cane basket, box, stickers etc.)
