

Welcome to Kindergarten Albury Public School



On the first day, go to the Kindergarten area in the West. This is where you line up in the mornings, after lunch and recess and at the end of the day. When the bell goes you will line up with your bag. Look for a badge with your name on it at the Kinder tables. Put on your badge and say hello to your new Kindergarten teacher.





You may recognise some friends you already know.

The Kindergarten playground is closed in the mornings.







When the green flag is up you can play on the equipment. When the green flag is away, there is no play on the equipment.

You will walk inside with your teacher and go to your classroom. The bag racks are outside the classroom for school bags and hats. Look for your name so you know where to put your bag.





There are four Kindergarten classrooms. All of them look a little different. What do you notice in this room?



You may not be in the same classroom you were in for orientation. Your new classroom may not look the same and that's okay.




You may not have the same teacher you had at orientation. It is okay to have a different teacher. You may be feeling a little nervous and excited.



Here is another Kindergarten classroom. Some rooms will have a coloured spot on the carpet for you to sit on.

The teacher will tell you about the activities for the day. We call this a timetable, and it will have pictures too.

It is good to know when things are going to happen, like when it is time to eat your fruit, lunch and recess, and when to play outside.





This is the Kindergarten eating area for lunch and recess near the large COLA. There are also bubblers nearby.







These are all the Kindergarten play areas. Only Kinders can play in these areas.









These are some of the out of bounds areas in the school.

A teacher on duty will remind you where to play and where not to play.





There are always teachers and SLSOs on duty in the morning, at lunch and recess. Teachers wear yellow vests and SLSOs wear orange vests. If you are unsure about something or need help, then ask one of our friendly teachers.





Other places at Albury Public School are the front office and sick bay.





You will visit the library once a week with the Teacher/Librarian Ms Griffith. The Library is upstairs and you can visit at lunch times too. You walk up and down the stairs on the left-hand side.





You will go to the hall for K-2 assemblies. The canteen is open at lunch and recess times.





When it is home time, you may get picked up at the West gate (parent pick up), go to bus lines under the COLA, or go to OOSH.
